



# REPORT OF THE RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

**Whereas** the GA 9th District Republican Party Chairman, Carl Blackburn, appointed Stephen Aaron, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice-Chairman of the GA 9th District Republican Party, Chairman of the Standing Committee on Resolutions (“the Committee”);

**Whereas** the Committee consist of the following individuals of the GA 9th District:

**Whereas** the Committee received nine (9) Resolutions submitted from three (3) county conventions and three (3) Resolutions submitted from three (3) individuals of the 9th District for a total of twelve (12) Resolutions submitted for consideration;

**Whereas** the twelve (12) total Resolutions submitted to the Committee covered twelve (12) different topics;
